

Student Information

BCT is committed to improving the quality of life in the region by providing safe, efficient, customer-oriented services to residents and guests of the South Bay and promoting environmentally-friendly, congestion-mitigating transportation alternatives.

HOW DO I GET A BCT STUDENT ID CARD?

Complete the BCT Student Application. Deliver the completed application along with \$1 processing fee in person Monday through Thursday between the 25th through the 7th of the month at City Hall (Door E) or send by mail.

HOW DO I GET A MONTHLY PASS STICKER TO RIDE?

Once you receive a BCT Student ID card, you may pay in person or by mail the bus pass payment to City Hall (Door E). Sales occur from the 25th day of the prior month through the 7th day of the purchase month. If you pay for multiple months, provide a self-addressed stamped envelope (SASE) for each month and we will mail your pass sticker at the end of each month for the following month's pass.

HOW MUCH IS A STUDENT MONTHLY PASS STICKER?

\$8.00 for Redondo Beach and Lawndale residents (*subject to Redondo Beach or Lawndale residency current utility bill verification*). \$20.00 for all other students.

HOW DO I PAY FOR A MONTHLY PASS STICKER?

You may pay for one month or more by mail (check or money order only & SASE *payable to City of Redondo Beach*) or pay at City Hall using cash, check, money order, MasterCard, Visa during sales days.

HOW MUCH IS THE FARE?

The fare is \$1 for regular and student riders. The fare is 50 cents for senior and disabled passengers.

CAN I PAY THE FARE WITH A TAP CARD?

You can pay the fare using a TAP card that has stored value. BCT bus passes are currently not on the TAP card system.

WHAT IF I LOSE MY BCT ID CARD?

To get a new BCT ID during sales days visit City Hall (Door E) to complete an application for replacement and pay \$5.00 replacement fee. Call (310) 937-6660 if you have any questions.

WHERE CAN I GET THE BCT BUS SCHEDULE?

IF I LEFT PERSONAL ITEMS ON THE BUS, WHAT SHOULD I DO?

BCT is not responsible for items left on vehicles or at bus stops. Call (310) 802-7686 to report a lost item.

WHY DON'T I ALWAYS GET A SEAT?

BCT Vehicles can carry up to 42 and 60 passengers. Riders may not always get a seat. Some riders may be required to stand.
