

**Bylaw**

---

RESIGNATION/REMOVAL FROM OFFICE

Whenever a member of a Bordentown Regional Board of Education shall cease to be a bona fide resident of the district which he/she represents, membership in the board shall immediately cease. Any member who fails to attend three (3) consecutive meetings of the board without good cause may be removed by the board.

If a board of education member is unable to attend a committee or agenda meeting, the member shall provide advance notice to the board secretary, board president, and if a committee meeting, the chair. A meeting is defined as any advertised regular or special meeting of the board of education.

A president or vice president of the board who shall refuse to perform a duty imposed upon him/her by law may be removed by a majority vote of all the members of the board. When the office of president becomes vacant, the vice president shall assume the responsibilities of the president. The board, within thirty (30) days thereafter, shall fill the vacancy of vice president for the unexpired term.
