Re: New immunization requirements for 2016

Under a new law known as SB 277, beginning January 1, 2016 exemptions based on personal beliefs, including religious beliefs, will no longer be an option for the vaccines that are currently required for entry into child care or school in California. Most families will not be affected by the new law because their children have received all required vaccinations. Personal beliefs exemptions on file for a child already attending child care or school will remain valid until the child reaches the next immunization checkpoint at kindergarten (including transitional kindergarten) or 7th grade.

Immunizations (shots) Needed Before Starting Child Care/Preschool

Age When Entering	Immunizations (shots) Required
2–3 Months	1 each of Polio, DTaP, Hib, Hep B
4–5 Months	2 each of Polio, DTaP, Hib, Hep B
6–14 Months	3 each of DTaP 2 each of Polio, Hib, Hep B
15–17 Months	3 each of Polio, DTaP 2 Hep B 1 MMR on or after the 1st birthday 1 Hib on or after the 1st birthday
18 months–5 years	3 Polio 4 DTaP 3 Hep B 1 MMR on or after the 1st birthday 1 Hib on or after the 1st birthday** 1 Varicella

**Required only for children less than 4 years, 6 months

DTaP = Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis

Hib = Haemophilus Influenzae type B

Hep B = Hepatitis B

MMR = Measles, Mumps, Rubella

Varicella = Chickenpox
