

9150.1 - Classroom Observation by Parent or Guardian

The Board of Education recognizes the importance of minimizing any disruption of classroom instruction while at the same time aware that there are times when it may be helpful to have a parent/guardian visit and observe their child's school program. Therefore, the school Principal may grant permission to a parent/guardian to observe a particular class, when in the judgment of the principal the request is educationally sound and presents only a minimal disruption of the educational process. In the case of a proposed placement of a special needs student, according to N.J.A.C.6A:14-4.1(k) the district board of education shall provide the parent with the opportunity to observe the proposed educational placement prior to implementation of the IEP.

Parent/Guardian may appeal a decision to the Superintendent whose decision will be final.
