



School Dance Information

School Dances are wonderful part of the high school experience. We encourage all students to participate in our dances. Having a safe environment for our students is of the utmost importance; therefore, guidelines have been established for all Seton students and their guests.

- ⇒ In order for a non-Seton Catholic student to be admitted to a Seton Catholic sponsored dance, this form MUST be completed and turned into the Vice Principal's office on the Wednesday at 3:15 prior to the dance.
- ⇒ All guests must be in high school and must bring to the dance a valid picture identification to be left at the door with an administrator/advisor.
- ⇒ Seton Catholic students are considered responsible for the transportation, safety, and behavior of their guests.
- ⇒ Admittance to the dance will stop 30 minutes after the beginning time of the dance. (Usually 8:30)
- ⇒ If students have pre-purchased their dance pass and they are not in the doors within 30 minutes after the beginning of the dance, then parents will be contacted. This is to ensure accountability of students' whereabouts for parents.
- ⇒ Students will not be allowed to leave the dance early.
- ⇒ A modified Dress Code is presented to students before the dance.
