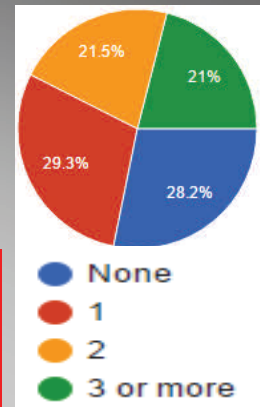

**Overall I feel my school is a positive place and I feel welcome here**

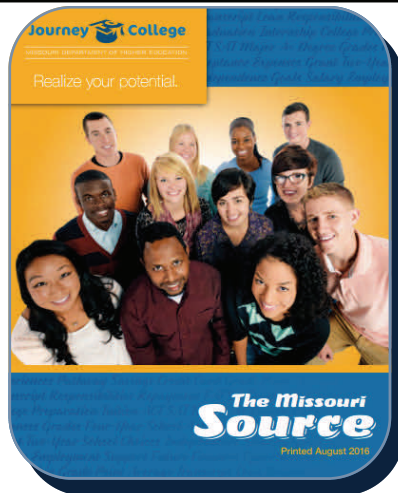
