Behavior, Bus/Limo, and Dress Code Guidelines for School Dances

This form must be returned to the USB office with the appropriate signatures or students and guests will not be admitted to the dance.

Dress Code Standards for Dances

The following dress code policy is in effect when students are attending on or off campus dances. Students who are not dressed appropriately will not be permitted to enter the dance and parents will be notified. No refunds will be given. Dress code guidelines as outlined in the Student Dress Code Policy in the Student Planner are expected to be honored and the following may apply:

- HOMECOMING AND PROM ARE EXPECTED TO BE SEMI-FORMAL OR FORMAL EVENTS. ATTIRE FOR BOYS MAY BE A TUXEDO OR A SUIT AND GIRLS MAY WEAR DRESSES THAT ARE STRAPLESS, HAVE A HALTER TOP OR HAVE A ONE SHOULDER STRAP.
- No overly revealing clothing may be worn including clothing where excessive cleavage is displayed or where the torso is exposed.
- No dresses or skirts may be worn that are excessively short and expose the posterior.
- No see-through clothing may be worn.
- No displaying undergarments of any kind.
- No clothing or jewelry may be worn that has any connotations that are offensive or dangerous.
- **All students and guests may be subject to a breathalyzer and/or sobriety test if the administration or local law enforcement deems it necessary.**

Behavior Guidelines

Behavior on and off the dance floor must be socially acceptable and adhere to all behavior guidelines of Diamond Bar High School. Dance movements and mannerisms must reflect the standards of modesty and good taste. Dance movements, commonly known as “Freaking” or “Grinding”, which depict or suggest private, sexual acts are a distraction or bothersome to others and deemed inappropriate and unacceptable. Physically dangerous dancing and movements, such as “slamming” or “moshing” are not allowed. Individuals, couples and/or groups engaging in such acts may be removed from the dance without refund and parents will be contacted. ****Students and guests will receive a wristband when they check in to the dance. Any student or guest dancing inappropriately will have their wristband removed and they will no longer be able to dance. A second incident will result in the removal of the student and/or guest from the dance entirely.**

Bus/Limo Policy

Diamond Bar High School staff and students are committed to creating a safe environment for all at our events. Students who decide to arrive to any event in a party bus, limo, etc. must understand that the vehicle will be searched upon arrival to the event. Once searched, if any substance is found in the vehicle or on another person that jeopardizes the safety of others at the event, such as but not limited to alcohol or other drugs, all passengers will be questioned. If a resolution cannot be found, all passengers who were in the vehicle will be denied access to the event. A parent/guardian will be contacted to pick up the students. Individuals who are found in possession or consumption of an illegal substance will be dismissed from the event and given consequences upon their return to school. Questions regarding this policy may be directed to the Assistant Principal, John Terry.

Proper identification is required by all for entrance into the dance. (Diamond Bar High students must bring their valid school ID, and guests must have a valid school ID or valid driver's license.) Diamond Bar High School is not responsible for lost or stolen items while at the dance. Please do not leave valuables unattended at any time. The check-in time for all dances will close at 8:30 p.m. Once you leave the building, you have permanently left the dance and will not be re-admitted. All students must be picked up by 11:00p.m. Failure to do so will result in the loss of privilege to attend future dances or Grad Nite.**
