High School Placement Test Success!

Congratulations to our 8th graders for their outstanding individual and group success on the November High School Placement Test. We are very proud of your efforts. Thank you to all the teachers, parents, and family members who have assisted these students in their academic journey. You are going to SOAR as you move into high school!

GROUP ACHIEVEMENTS

- 33 students took the test in November
- The group composite bested the national average by 28 percentile points
- Four students achieved the 99th NPR, the highest percentile rank possible
- Seven students scored in the 90th-98th NPR
- 12% of our students scored in the top 1%
- 33% of our students scored in the top 10%
- 50% of our students scored in the top 25%
- 80% of our students scored in the top 50%
- Collectively averaged above the 9th grade equivalency in all three areas – Reading, Math, Language
