We operate two houses of hospitality in Stillwater, Our Lady Queen of Peace House and Solanus Casey House. In these homes we strive to provide a loving supportive community for our guests.

Guests are typically those most vulnerable in our population, homeless women and their children. The day to day operations of the houses is overseen by the House Supervisory Council.

Our houses of hospitality would not be able to function without help from volunteers and donations from the community.

Security

These homes are meant to be safe places for guests and volunteers. The address and location of our homes, as well as telephone numbers are not given out to anyone without permission.

Expectations regarding Curfew, Visitors, meals, food, housekeeping, guest rooms, personal property, areas not intended for guest use, cars, television, transportation, communication, meetings, room placement, prohibition of pets, drugs and alcohol are discussed and agreed upon with guests before they move into Peace House.

ILLEGAL DRUGS AND ALCOHOL ARE NOT PERMITTED ON THE PREMISES. Use of any controlled substance, even off the premises is not allowed. Violations will lead to immediate eviction.
