EXECUTIVE OFFICE ON EARLY LEARNING (EOEL) PUBLIC PRE-KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2018-2019 BEGINNING MARCH 1, 2018

Visit your nearest school with an EOEL Public Pre-Kindergarten Program to request an application. You may also download an application from earlylearning.hawaii.gov or www.hawaiipublicschools.org (search for "Early Learning"). Complete and submit your application along with all required documents to the school where you are applying. You will be notified by mail of your application status.

To qualify, families must meet certain eligibility requirements.

- Children must be age four on or before July 31 of the current school year.
 - For school year 2018 - 2019, children born on or between August 1, 2013 - July 31, 2014 are eligible.
- See application packet for priority categories that your child may be eligible for which may include the income levels below:

Enrollment

Each pre-kindergarten class is limited to 20 students. Once eligibility requirements are met, enrollment is based on the order in which schools receive completed applications and all required documents. Until April 30, 2018, priority is given to students who live in the geographic area of the school. Once spaces are filled, remaining eligible applicants will be placed on a waitlist.

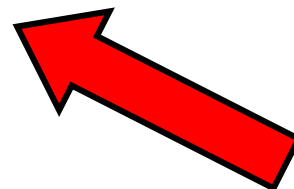
