

Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA) and Acceptable Use/Internet Safety Policy Agreement (2016-2017)

COPPA provides parents with certain rights and control over the information collected online from children under the age of 13. Before students under the age of 13 may provide their name, email address, or other information online, parents must give permission for students to use the online website. Below is a list of websites used educationally for student projects where a student's name, email address, etc. may be released to a website to setup an online space to complete assignments.
