January 6, 2016

- A. Movement to adopt the minutes of the previous meeting
 - Anita Oudega moved to adopt the minutes.

- C. Survey discussion and review
 - Surveys have been slightly altered since the previous meeting. Will be reviewed by the LCAP committee before going to cabinet for their review.
 - Discussion of limitations of yes/no responses in the survey which would result in a 50% split. Question raised as to the flexibility or lack thereof of such a response being included.
 - Discussion of separating the credentialed employee survey from the classified employee survey since the current survey is worded mainly for credentialed employees.
 - Following was a discussion regarding specific items on the survey.
 - #19 of credentialed survey - discussion regarding the most appropriate platform for possible student email system; Aeries or Microsoft 360. Current problems with Edline vs. Aeries regarding parent communication.
 - #22 -23 - Differentiation needs to be re-addressed based on changes in curriculum and terminology. Changes in wording will be made
 - #31 - Really geared towards grades 8 - 12. This will be indicated on the survey.
 - Elementary survey comments
 - #4 - Grammar correction
 - #7 - Eliminate
 - #10 -12 - Grammar correction
 - #11 - spacing; frequency of use of technology
 - #13 - "I feel like I can talk to my principal".
 - Parent survey comments
 - #4 - "highly skilled"; strike the question.
 - #15 - "I"
 - #16 - needs to be rephrased
 - #20 - 21 - consolidate or differentiate the language further
 - Secondary student survey comment
 - #19 - further graduate answer choices

- **Add a question about learning climate. Discussion centered on improving student collaboration vs. competition in classes at the secondary level.**

- **Michael shared his work at the State Board. There is currently a discussion at the state level about how to replace the API scores previously assigned to schools and districts. There is no clear direction at the moment.**
