- Complete all homework assignments and seek assistance if necessary. I will ask questions if I do not understand.**
- Follow teacher's directions promptly and behave according to school expectations.**
 - I commit to living the 6 P's and use the skills learned in the Discovery Class and understand that if I reach 10 points on the discipline scale, I may be removed from the Horizon Program.
- Take advantage of before or after school assistance as necessary.**
