QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Minimum of two years of college or 60 college credit hours
- 2. Approval Card issued by the Maine Department of Education (CHRC)

REPORTS TO: Building Principal or Designee

JOB GOAL: To enable each child to pursue his or her education as smoothly and completely as possible in the absence of the regular teacher.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Reports to the building principal or designee upon arrival at the school building.
- 2. Reviews student lists and plans/schedules to be followed during the teaching day and asks the principal/designee for any necessary clarification.
- 3. Maintains as fully as possible the established routines and procedures of the school and classroom to which assigned.
- 4. Teaches the lesson outlined and described in the absent teacher's lesson plans.
- 5. Consults as appropriate with the building principal or designee before initiating any teaching or other procedures not specified in the absent teacher's lesson plan.
- 6. Assumes responsibility for overseeing pupil behavior and general well-being in class and during duty periods.
- 7. Follows all policies, rules, and procedures to which regular teachers are subject and which good teaching practice dictates.

WORK YEAR: As-needed basis. Salary and benefits to be established by the School Committee.

EVALUATION: Performance of this job will be evaluated in accordance with provisions of the School Committee's policy on evaluation.
