



Palos Verdes Peninsula Council of PTAs 2018 Honorary Service Award Nominations

Honorary Service Awards (HSA) are available to recognize the service and dedication of both individuals and organizations who exemplify the best in volunteering to the well-being of children, youth or families in this community. The nominee does not have to hold a PTA position or have to be an official member of this body. The completed nominations forms will be submitted to the PVP Council of PTAs HSA committee by no later than March 2, 2018, to be considered for an award. The nomination form should describe in detail the service for which the individual or organization is being nominated.

Peacock Award – This award is given by PVP Council of PTAs to recognize an individual(s) that have performed outstanding service to our Council.

Very Special Person Award (VSP) – This award is given to recognize an individual or organization that has positively impacted a project, school, and/or a community program, and for their outstanding service to PTA by giving freely and unselfishly of their time.

Honorary Service Award (HSA) – This award is given to recognize an individual or organization for outstanding service to children and youth in your community, by going above and beyond their normal volunteer position.

Continuing Service Award (CSA) – This award is given to recognize an individual or organization for ongoing or long-time outstanding service to children and youth in your community. They go above and beyond by providing support year after year.

Outstanding Teacher Award (OTA) – This award may be given to recognize a teacher for outstanding service to children and youth through PTA, school, or community.

Outstanding Administrator Award (OAA) – This award may be given to recognize an administrator for outstanding service to children and youth through PTA, school, or the community.

Golden Oak Service Award (GOSA) – This award is the most prestigious of the Honorary Service Awards, and given to recognize an individual or organization that has made significant contributions to the welfare of children and youth in a school or community for multiple years and levels. This individual or organization would have most likely received an HSA award(s) in the past for their extraordinary service towards others.

DONATIONS: *Donations may be given by PTA or by individuals in tribute to a person, group or in memoriam. The donation may be made in any amount. A separate form is required for submission.*
