ESSA Title IA, Targeted Assistance

Each school served under Title I, Part A must convene an annual meeting to inform parents of their school's participation in Title I, Part A programs, to explain the Title I, Part A requirements, how the Title I students will be assessed, how the parents will be kept informed, and the right of parents to be involved in those programs. This meeting must be at a time convenient for parents. In order to keep parents informed, schools should invite all parents of children participating in Title I, Part A programs and encourage them to attend.

FLPS Intervention Programming

- Supplemental programming for students whose assessment data and/or classroom performance indicate that they would benefit from additional academic support in:
 - English Language Arts
 - Mathematics
 - *Both*
- Designed to meet the unique needs of struggling learners, recognizing that learners grow at varying rates.
- Success of program relies on tiers of support that begin with the general education classroom and continue with intervention teachers
- Instruction varies depending on the nature and severity of student difficulty
- Instructional materials are tailored to meet the needs of diverse learners and are provided by both local and federal Title IA funding

Intervention Classes

Intervention is *in addition to* regular classroom instruction. Intervention provides for increased levels of intensity and practice by increasing instructional time and decreasing group size for more targeted instruction.

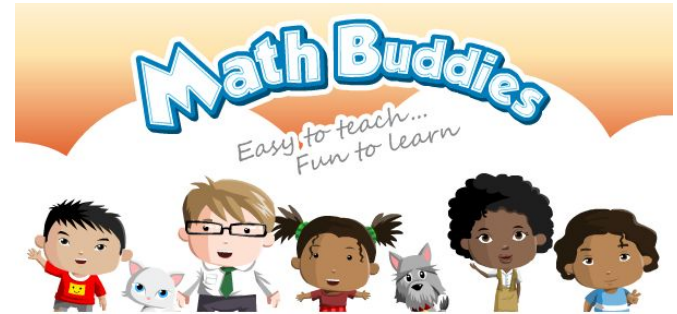

Gr. K-5 Math CSI Programming

- Aims to improve students' basic skills and number sense - ranging from counting and proper number formation for younger children to multiplication and division facts for children in the upper grades
- Math CSI Instruction is differentiated based on student needs with a goal of improving in content and skills identified as needing further support and focus
- Intervention teachers are in constant communication with your child's math teacher
- Student progress is monitored using a variety of assessments and observation

Instructional Resources include:

K-5 Language Arts CSI Programming

- Aims to support development of the essential skills and strategies to help students read and respond with independence in line with grade-level expectations
- Instruction supports development of reading skills across genres and text types - with emphasis on learning how to effectively read and comprehend nonfiction to support academic studies
- Instruction emphasizes reading, discussing, and writing about literature
- Prepares students to be able to cite text evidence during discussions and in written responses to reading
- Intervention teachers are in constant communication with your child's classroom teacher
- Student progress is monitored using a variety of assessments and observation
- Small group instruction allows us to tailor instruction based upon specific individual needs
