

PHILOSOPHY, GOALS, OBJECTIVES, AND COMPREHENSIVE PLANS

Goals for the School District

The Board of Trustees shall annually adopt a set of annual priority areas and activities as identified through the Five-Year Plan. The Five-Year Plan shall reflect the specific priority areas for the immediate school year and the years to follow. The Superintendent shall present the Five-Year Plan, including goals and objectives, to the Board of Trustees for their approval. The goals and objectives should reflect input from a variety of stakeholders, including parents, staff, and the community at large, while considering student performance data, and federal and state legislation.

The Five-Year Plan shall be consistent with the District Vision, Mission, and Core Values and is to be developed within the construct of sound fiscal practices. The Five-Year Plan shall include at a minimum goals and objectives on issues relative to Safety, Accountability and Student Performance, and Communication with Employees and Community. There shall be clear performance standards and benchmarks which can be used to determine if the District is meeting its goals.
