

## San Ramon Valley High School Parking/Driving Regulations

All drivers of motorized vehicles are to observe existing state and local vehicle code provisions. Drivers and passengers must obey all school regulations and observe safety at all times while in their vehicles on or about school property. Students who endanger the lives of others in the parking lots by speeding or reckless driving are subject to citation by local police, and are subject to disciplinary action. Disciplinary action may include, but is not limited to, suspension or more severe consequences, and the loss or suspension of the parking pass.

The following are specific school rules that must be observed:

- a) The current SRVHS parking sticker must be visible, and be stuck to the vehicle.
- b) All carpool members must ride in the vehicle to be eligible for parking in the spot.
- c) The speed limit in all parking lots and driveways is 5 mph.
- d) Parking in unauthorized spaces is never allowed. Cars that are illegally parked are subject to a parking ticket and towing charges. Drivers who continue to abuse parking regulations will lose their school vehicle use privileges and are subject to school disciplinary action (Ed Code 48990 sub section K).
- e) Loitering is prohibited in all parking lots before school, during break and after school.
- f) The parking lot and vehicles are off-limits during the school day.
- g) Cars cannot be used or accessed during the school day (i.e., to eat in, as a locker, etc.).
- h) Reckless or any unsafe driving is prohibited.
- i) Since your car is on campus, it is also subject to search should a discipline issue arise.

If your parking spot is ever taken by another vehicle, you need to park in the staff parking lot. Please do not park in another student parking spot. After you park in staff parking, all you need to do is sign in at the attendance office and you will receive a pass to class.

Campus parking lots will be randomly monitored throughout the day. If a car is found to not have the appropriate number of carpoolers, the following consequences may be enforced:

- *First Offense:* Warning; parents contacted
- *Second Offense:* Detention for the driver; parents contacted
- *Third Offense:* Suspension of permit for a month; parents contacted
- *Fourth Offense:* Suspension of permit for the remainder of the semester, parents contacted

Remember that parking on campus is a privilege. Observing the rules and guidelines stated above shows your respect for each other and for SRVHS. Our expectation is that you will help keep our campus a safe and positive environment.
