

**A Meeting of the Copper Canyon Elementary Community Council Convened at 4pm on 10/16/2012 in the school library**

**Trustland Plan: Final Report for 2011-2012 and Funding Revision for 2012 and 2013**

The Trustland monies Copper Canyon will be receiving for this school year are \$30,625. This is approximately \$3500 more than was anticipated.

The community council discussed options for using this additional money to benefit instruction and student learning at Copper Canyon.

Clint Spindler noted that we have mounted about half of the classroom projectors already and that the cost of mounting projectors has increased to \$800 per projector.

Yvonne Turner asked Linda Clegg for her opinion from a teacher's perspective.

Linda Clegg noted that she uses her projector in her classroom on a daily basis and that she also values professional development.

**Motion:** Jennifer Lords moved to use the additional Trustland money to mount four classroom projectors and the balance to be used for materials and opportunity for staff development. Yvonne Turner seconded. Vote was unanimous. Motion carried.
