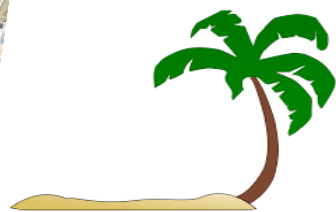
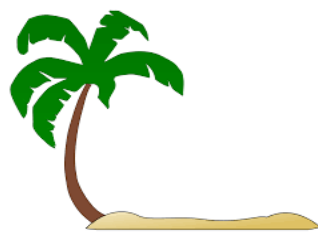
Course Dates: August 13-16, 2018 (Mon-Thurs) **Time:** 9:00 AM - 12:00 PM

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Smith Summer School policies & rules

General Policies: Classroom disciplinary problems and/or concerns should and will be minimal. All students are expected to behave in a mature and responsible manner.

Attendance: Attendance for class sessions is required as it is a one-week course.

Dress Code: Students may wear shorts. However, they must fall below the student's fingertips when their arms are at their sides. No halter-tops, bare midriiffs, tank tops, or spaghetti strap tops are acceptable when worn alone. Acceptable tops must have straps that are approximately three fingers wide. No clothing with inappropriate messages may be worn. No hats or head covering may be worn in school unless religiously mandated. Clothing should be of proper fit and not revealing. Baggy pants that display underwear are unacceptable. For safety reasons, shoes are to be worn at all times. Students who wear inappropriate clothing will be asked to change or call their parents to bring them appropriate clothing. This is a level 1 violation as outlined in the Troy School District's Rights and Responsibilities Code of Student Conduct.

Students will be participating in many hands on activities and should wear comfortable clothing that they can move around in. Some activities will take place outside. Students will be given advanced notice of these days and are encouraged to bring a hat and sunscreen.

Cellular Phones and iPods: Cellular phones or iPod use during the day is prohibited.

A warning will be given for all level I violations. Students will be dropped from the program on the second offense of a level I violation or any infraction of a level II or III violation.
