

DHS Prom 2018: Frequently Asked Questions {updated with location & details}

General Information	
1. Who can attend prom?	1. All Duluth HS Juniors and Seniors are invited to attend the Prom each spring; the Junior Class hosts the Prom for the Senior Class. Each DHS Junior and Senior must have paid his/her JUNIOR DUES in order to attend the Prom. {This is separate from your Senior Dues.}
2. When is Prom 2018?	2. The prom is Saturday, April 28 th at 7pm. The DHS Prom will end promptly at 11:00pm. Your ride must be at <i>The Biltmore</i> to pick you up by 11:00pm.
3. Where is Prom 2018?	3. The Biltmore ~ 817 West Peachtree Street NW, Atlanta, GA 30308.
Junior Dues	
4. How much are Junior dues?	4. Junior dues are \$100 through March 18 th and will increase to \$125 on March 19 th ; you may pay at MyPaymentsPlus.com through April 8 th . Beginning April 9 th , dues will increase to \$150 and students must pay their dues in exact cash or money order to Mrs. Glaser in 526 before or after school. <i>Please note that once Junior dues have been paid, they are non-refundable and non-transferrable.</i>
5. Where do I pay dues?	5. You may pay dues at MyPaymentsPlus.com through April 9 th . You may also pay by money order (made payable to Duluth HS) or exact cash to Mrs. Glaser in room 526 until April 20 th . Personal checks will not be accepted after March 30th.
6. What is the last date to pay Junior dues?	6. The last day to pay Junior Dues (money order or exact cash) and to purchase a date ticket is Friday, April 20 th before 315pm.
Date Tickets	
7. How much is a Date ticket?	7. <i>Date tickets are \$50 each and must be purchased from Mrs. Glaser in room 526 before April 20th.</i> Please pay with exact cash or a money order; checks will not be accepted after March 30 th . {There is no online option to pay for Date tickets at this time.}
8. When do tickets go on sale?	8. You may purchase your Date ticket from Mrs. Glaser in room 526 March 23 rd through April 15 th . Your Junior dues must be paid before you may purchase a Date ticket. Once purchased, you MUST give your Date's Name <i>as it is printed on his/her PHOTO IDENTIFICATION</i> (school id card or driver's license) to Mrs. Glaser no later than April 15th.
9. How many tickets may I purchase?	9. Each Junior or Senior who has paid his/her dues will be allowed to purchase one (1) Date ticket.
10. What if my date is a Junior or Senior at Duluth High School?	10. If your date is a Junior or Senior at Duluth HS, s/he must pay (or have paid) his/her Junior dues in order to attend the Prom.
11. Who needs a date ticket?	11. You will need to purchase a Date ticket, if your date is a freshman or sophomore at Duluth High School or if your date does not attend Duluth High School. <i>If your prom is 21 or older, s/he must meet with a Duluth HS administrator prior to the 2018 Prom. If your date is from another high school we must have a conduct from completed by his/her home school (counseling or administration). Please see Mrs. Glaser for the form.</i>
12. May I switch or sell my ticket?	12. You may NOT! Ticket numbers are recorded by student names. At the Prom, only the official ticket holder will be admitted to the dance with his/her ticket and photo identification.

Dance Behavior & Dress Code

<p>13. What is the Prom dress code?</p>	<p>13. LADIES – NO LOW CUT, TWO-PIECE, SEE THROUGH, BARE-MIDRIFF, EXCESSIVELY REVEALING (FRONT AND/OR BACK) OR SHORT DRESSES WILL BE ALLOWED. {Sneakers and tennis shoes are not allowed.} If you think your dress is in violation of this dress code, please bring a picture with you wearing the dress to an administrator’s office. <i>Students in violation of the dress code policy WILL be asked to leave.</i> Please do not make us send you home from this special event because of your dress. (If you have a question about your dress, please see Ms. Heaton.) GENTLEMEN – JACKETS AND TIES ARE REQUIRED. Shirts must be worn at all times. NO JEANS ALLOWED. NO sneakers/tennis shoes are allowed. <i>Any form of dress, hairstyle, or makeup which is considered contrary to good hygiene or which is distracting or disruptive to the educational process will not be permitted. Parents are asked to assist the school by regularly monitoring their student's dress.</i></p>
<p>14. Is there a behavior policy at Prom?</p>	<p>14. SUGGESTIVE OR INAPPROPRIATE DANCING WILL NOT BE ALLOWED! This is a school sponsored event and <i>not a dancing club.</i> Please understand you will be asked to leave, if you cannot dance appropriately.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No glow sticks or open containers of any kind will be allowed. • This is a school sponsored event; therefore, ALL GCPS and Duluth High School Rules APPLY. • <i>Photo ID will be required upon check-in.</i> Please have your photo ID ready when you arrive. • Duluth High School students who are planning to bring a non-DHS student to the prom as his/her date <i>are responsible for sharing this information with your Date.</i> Please see Mrs. Glaser in 526 for a date form, if s/he is from another school. <i>If your prom date is 21 or older, s/he must meet in person with a Duluth HS administrator prior to Prom.</i> • Prom will end promptly at 11pm; you must have a ride at the prom site to pick you up.
<p>15. What is the attendance policy the day before Prom?</p>	<p>15. Students must be present for the entire day on Friday, April 27th in order to attend Prom on Saturday, April 28th. There will be an attendance roster at the door/check-in to cross-reference this information. Students who are suspended or expelled during this time are not allowed to attend any GCPS school function, including, but not limited to, Prom. If you have paid your dues and/or purchased a date ticket, you will not receive a refund.</p>

<p>17. What are the best directions to the prom site?</p>	<p>17. Parking for students is available at the AT&T Parking Deck at 759 West Peachtree St NW, Atlanta, GA 30308. <i>(Car service drop-off is at 817 West Peachtree Street NW, Atlanta, GA 30308.)</i></p>
<p>18. When will I pick up my ticket?</p>	<p>18. The week before prom tickets will be available in your prom packet. Your driver's license or school photo ID must be on your person as you enter prom.</p>
