

St. Joseph School Health Requirements

Required for EACH Student every school year

- Saint Joseph School Health History Form filled out online. Please click on the following link: <https://goo.gl/gQ7pGe>

New Students to St. Joseph School or from Out of State

- Physical Examination by an Illinois physician on an Illinois health form with health history signed by parents
- Eye examination if entering school for the first time from out of state

Both exams must be completed within one year prior to the date the student enters school.

All Students entering Preschool at St. Joseph School for the first time

- Physical Examination with health history signed by parents including the pneumococcal vaccine

All Students entering Kindergarten

- Physical Examination with health history signed by parents with 2 doses of the varicella vaccine
- Dental examination
- Eye examination

All three exams must be completed within one year prior to August 17, 2017.

All students entering 2nd Grade

- Dental Examination

The exam must be completed within one year prior to August 17, 2017.

All students entering 6th Grade

- Physical Examination with health history signed by parents. **These physicals will count for the sport physical but must be on the State of Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination form and not a sport physical form.**
- Required immunizations include 3 doses of the Hepatitis Vaccine, 2 doses of the Varicella Vaccine, a Tdap booster and the Meningococcal vaccine.
- Dental Examination

Both exams must be completed within one year prior to August 17, 2017.

All student's in 5th-8th Grade playing school sports

- Sports Physical

The exam must be completed within the year prior to participating in the school sport.

6th grade full physicals count as sport physicals.

No student will be allowed to practice without a physical on file in the nurse's office.

All physical, dental and vision exams are to be completed and returned to the nurse's office by October 16, 2017. All of the necessary forms may be found on the St. Joseph School website.
