Dear Parents and Guardians:

Greetings from the Office for Catholic Education, where we are honored to serve you and your children in this awesome ministry of Catholic education. Each year at this time, I am reminded of the unique privilege that I have to serve in this historic city where Saint John Neumann once served and, in his day, ushered in a new era for Catholic education. As the founder of America's first Catholic schools, this great saint remains a source of inspiration for us. Be assured that his aspiration remains ours today: to establish a Catholic school system that sets the standard for excellence, innovation, and growth across the United States.

Our leading edge curricula and innovative teaching strategies support Archdiocesan students in performing above the national percentile in standardized tests. Our students perform better than their counterparts in SATs with increased scores in writing, reading, and mathematics over the past five year trend. College acceptance is at 98% across our schools and the Class of 2016 was awarded over \$330 million in college scholarships, the highest award so far.

With that in mind, I am enclosing our new tuition rates for the 2017-18 school year with this letter. We never take for granted the investment that you make in your child and we have worked hard to minimize these increases. I am also proud to let you know that we have increased the amount of funding available for tuition assistance thanks to the hard work of our school presidents, BLOCS and the Faith in the Future Foundation. In fact, in 2016-17 the total of all financial aid awards and scholarship awards exceeded \$20 million. This has allowed us to award 76% of total need across our 17 high schools.

We will continue using Smart Tuition to manage the tuition and fee payments for all of our high schools. The tuition charge and the "School Fee" will be billed to you over 11 months starting in June 2017 and ending in April 2018. More information on re-enrolling for Smart Tuition will be sent to you in the next few months and we encourage all parents to sign up for electronic payments.

On behalf of the entire Secretariat for Catholic Education and the people of the Archdiocese, thank you for sharing the gift of your child with us and for making such a significant investment in their future and the future of our Church!

### TUITION PAYMENT SCHEDULE 2017-2018 \*

Listed below are the tuition and school fee rates for the 2017-18 school year. The applicable tuition charges and the school fee will be billed over **11 months** from June through April. Any grants or scholarships will be applied to those charges. Payments will continue to be made to Smart Tuition and there is a \$35 per family charge due in June 2017. This fee is waived for families paying in full or by semester. Families that sign up and make all payments electronically will receive a \$100 credit at the end of the school year. The monthly late fee if tuition is not paid on time will be \$30. In Smart Tuition you have the option to have your payment due the 1st of each month or the 15th of each month.

During the year, additional fees will appear on your monthly statement for registration, athletics and other school charges.

**Tuition Refund Policy for the 2017-18 School Year**

Students who leave school prior to April 1st, either voluntarily or because of school policies, receive a pro-rated refund if they have fully paid tuition in advance of the transfer. Scholarship and grant awards are also prorated upon withdrawal. If there is a balance due after adjusting the charges, there is no refund and the balance must be paid before official transcripts can be released.

**Only Tuition and the School Fee are prorated. Registration fees and various other school fees are non refundable.** Tuition refunds are not provided for withdrawals after March 31st.

The following schedules show the tuition due for students who withdraw during the year. Upon withdrawal, the prorated tuition charge for the month will apply. The amount of your refund will also depend upon other fees due and the amount paid to date. Families who decide not to have their child/guardian in school in September must notify the school as soon as possible, but not later than August 28 to avoid any tuition charge.

**TUITION PAYMENT SCHEDULE FOR 2017-18  
FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS**

The Archdiocese of Philadelphia is certified by the Student and Exchange Visitor Program to enroll foreign students eligible for a F-1 Visa. Students must live with a blood relative or must come to us through an Archdiocesan approved agency. An approved agency is one that has demonstrated a commitment to the Standards for International Educational Travel as outlined by the Council on Standards for International Educational Travel (CSIET). Enrollment and tuition charges are subject to agreements between the agency(ies) and the school and Archdiocesan Office of Catholic Education.

A registration fee is due upon acceptance at the school. If enrolling for the Fall, the full tuition charges must be paid before the school year begins. If accepted during a school year, the full tuition and fee charges apply unless the student is enrolled in the second semester. If that is the case, one half of the tuition and fee charges are due.

During the year, additional fees will appear on your monthly statement for registration, athletics and other school charges.

If a student withdraws during the first semester of the school year, any tuition and fees paid for the second semester will be refunded.

If a student withdraws after the second semester has begun, no refunds are issued.
