Who Qualifies for this Program??

If you or your family meets any of the following living situations:

- In temporary housing such as a motel, vehicle or camping
- Living in a Domestic violence shelter
- On the Street, couch-surfing
- In an abandoned building, trailer, or other inadequate accommodations, or
- Staying in Substandard housing
- Doubled up with friends or relatives because you cannot find or afford housing
- Non-accompanied, independent youth

You and your family have the right to:

- Go to school, no matter where you live or how long you have lived there.
- Continue in the school you last attended, if that is your choice and is feasible.
- Receive transportation to the school you attended last (within reason, safety first)
- Attend and participate in school programs
- Enroll in school without giving a permanent address
- Enroll in a new school without immunizations, proof of residential status, school records, proof of guardianship or other documents

Here are some things the Transitional Youth Services Coordinator can assist with to improve educational outcomes:

- CASE MANAGEMENT FOR EDUCATION RIGHTS
- ADVOCATE FOR COMMUNITY RESOURCES FOR ENTIRE FAMILY
- BACKPACKS & SCHOOL SUPPLIES FOR STUDENTS
- EDUCATIONAL ENRICHMENT
- SCHOOL CLOTHING FOR STUDENTS
- EMERGENCY FOOD SUPPLIES
- LEADERSHIP ACTIVITIES
- FREE AND REDUCED LUNCHES

The program also assists children aged 0-5 in preparation for positive transition to Kindergarten.
