Peer intervention on the playground has the biggest impact on bullying prevention; potentially helping decrease the occurrence of bullying incidents to 4% compared to 11% with adult intervention, and 85% with no intervention. 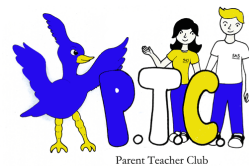
Mark Your Calendar: The 2nd PTC General Meeting is on Thursday, January 18th beginning at 6pm
