

JESSICA CLARK MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP
Scholarship Announcement & Application
PULLMAN EDUCATION FOUNDATION

This is an annual scholarship given in memory of Jessica Clark who graduated from Pullman High School in 1997. Her life was tragically shortened by an automobile accident in the summer of 1999.

Requirements: 2018 Pullman High School graduate

Award Criteria: The successful applicant must be:

- A graduating female senior at Pullman High School
- Has been accepted into an institution of higher learning
- A participant in interscholastic athletics at PHS with preference for volleyball and fast-pitch softball
- Consistently demonstrating: a strong work ethic by always going above and beyond; compassion for others by being there for other people and by being a good listener; leadership potential, but not necessarily by being at the forefront.

Amount of Scholarship: **\$1,000** — Non-recurring scholarship to be used for tuition at the college or university of your choice during fall semester 2018. The scholarship award will be paid directly to the college of the successful applicant's choice on their behalf.

Application Process:

- Applicants must submit application form (back of this sheet)
- Official Transcript submitted with application
- Submit a letter of application addressing the criteria
- Applicants must have at least two letters of reference submitted which address the criteria (one letter must be from the applicant's coach and one from another adult who knows the applicant well)

APPLICATION DEADLINE: **April 13, 2018.** Turn in hardcopy application with any required materials at the Counseling Center. Incomplete applications or applications received after the deadline will NOT be considered.

Review of applicants is done by the PHS Scholarship Committee (which could include PEF and Jessica's parents). The Scholarship will be presented at the annual PHS Awards Night to culminate the year. A permanent plaque identifying each recipient would be placed in the foyer at PHS. The PULLMAN EDUCATION FOUNDATION reserves the right to alter, amend, withdraw or terminate this scholarship offer at any time and reserves the right not to award this scholarship, all within the sole discretion of the PULLMAN EDUCATION FOUNDATION.
