

Spotlight on “Fundraising” with Gift Cards

Cape Trinity Catholic’s non-profit status allows us to participate in a “scrip program” where retailers sell us gift cards at a discount. This discount is called the “non-profit contribution”.

When you shop with CTC Gift Cards and/or give them as gifts, you enable CTC to grab “non-profit contributions” a.k.a. FREE MONEY!

To take full advantage of this opportunity, CTC offers families the option of allocating a portion of the non-profit contributions generated by their orders towards their CAPE TRINITY CATHOLIC or WILDWOOD CATHOLIC tuition bill for next year.

Non-profit contributions vary by retailer and some offer increased contribution “specials” throughout the year. The full non-profit contribution rate is listed on the paper order forms as well as on-line at www.shopwithscrip.com.

When you complete the Scrip Program Agreement, you designate the allocation of the non-profit contributions, between CTC and your tuition account. The non-profit contribution money that you allocate to CTC goes directly towards our operating budget. Achieving our total operating budget goals allows CTC to maintain our educational programs and our building at our current tuition rate.

It is important to note that CTC makes NO money from this program until you 1) use it and 2) allocate a portion of the non-profit contributions to CTC on the Scrip Program Agreement!

Bottom Line: It’s FREE MONEY, it’s EASY and it doesn’t cost you anything! Why not give it a try?
