A Summary of Actions by the Board of Trustees Special Called Meeting of February 7, 2012

The Board of Trustees met on February 7, 2012, at 6:55 p.m. for the purpose of holding a special called meeting. Members present were Joe Ruelas - President, Scott Aaron - Vice President, Joel Hardeman, Maria Jones, and Mike Tincher. Scott Elder - Secretary and David Bullock were absent.

Action Item:

- The Board approved the qualifications and characteristics for the superintendent search. In concert with the staff, students, and the community, the Board of Trustees has identified certain characteristics and qualifications as highly desirable in a superintendent:
 - An effective communicator with superior interpersonal skills.
 - A successful record of improving student achievement.
 - A motivational leader who is attentive to staff morale, and has a proven ability to build an effective management team.
 - Knows school financial management and state funding laws.
 - Bond and construction planning and management experience is preferred.
 - A "people" person who is approachable, open minded, and optimistic.
 - Able to work in partnership with the Board of Trustees to build a team of eight, establishing a climate of mutual trust and cooperation.
 - An honest person of integrity with high moral standards.
 - Served in a district of similar size and demographics: superintendent experience is preferred.
 - Committed to Mineral Wells for the long term and becoming an active member of the district and community.
