### 2. Sponsor

### 3. Agreement to Official Rules

### 4. Contest Period

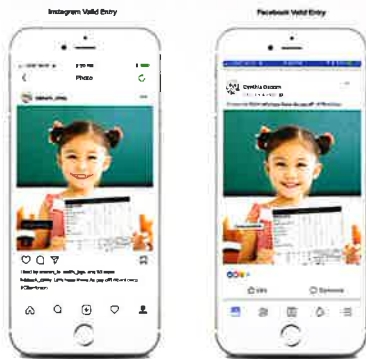
The Contest begins on April 02, 2018 at 12:00AM CST and ends on April 20, 2018 at 11:59PM CST (the "Contest Period"). Entries that are submitted before or after the Contest Period will be disqualified. Submissions will be accepted for the duration of the contest using any of the following methods:

### 5. How to Enter

Entrants must:

1. Like Centennial BANK's Facebook page or follow @benkoncb on Instagram.
2. Post a photo of their eligible child holding their Participating ISD's report card from grading period between February 26, 2018-April 20, 2018 (School/ISD must be visible) to their own Facebook Timeline or Instagram Feed.
3. Tag the respective Centennial BANK profile in the photo.
4. Post with hashtag #CBambition.
5. Do not post on both Facebook AND Instagram. Choose one. Should an entrant post to both their Instagram and Facebook, their entry will be disqualified.

Limit one (1) entry per person, per Facebook/Instagram account and per household for the duration of the Contest Period, regardless of method of entry. Entries received from any person, Facebook/Instagram account or household in excess of the stated limitation will be void. All entries become the property of Sponsor and will not be acknowledged or returned.



### 6. Prize Drawing

On or about April 23, 2018, the Sponsor will select potential winners at random from among all entries received. The odds of being selected depend upon the number of entries received. The Sponsor will attempt to notify the potential winner via direct message on or about April 23, 2018. If the potential winner cannot be contacted within five (5) days after the date of the first attempt to contact him/her, the Sponsor may select an alternate potential winner in his/her place from the remaining non-winning, eligible entries.

### 7. Winner Notification

The potential winners will be notified by direct message. Each potential Grand Prize winner (parent/legal guardian if a minor in his/her legal state of residence) will be required to complete, electronically sign and submit a Declaration of Compliance within five (5) days of the date notice or attempted notice is sent, in order to claim his/her prize.
