Snyder ISD ACE is a Texas ACE™ (Afterschool Centers on Education) grant program administered by the Texas Education Agency (TEA) and funded by the U.S. Department of Education's 21st Century Community Learning Centers program.

Snyder ISD has presently been awarded a \$ 1,000,000 grant for each year of the three years during the Tx21st CCLC Cycle 9 grant initiative. Beginning its first year of Cycle 9 during the 2016-2017 school year, ACE offers tuition-free before/after school and weekend academic and enrichment activities for PK—8th grade students, parents and teachers. ACE also offers six weeks of summer camps.

ACE activities focus on four areas:
