Students will not be admitted after the event begins.</i></p>	

OTHER INFORMATION

- ★ Any senior who has **outstanding debts** must have these paid to the appropriate person and receipted by **May 1, 2018**. Receipts should be presented to Mrs. Ray to clear the debt. These include, but not limited to, athletic uniforms, AP exam fees, damaged or lost books, fines, fundraisers, etc.
- ★ Each senior will be given a **maximum of 6 tickets** for their guests to attend Graduation ceremonies **if held in Dixon Auditorium**. *Admittance will only be granted with a ticket*. If ceremonies are held in the stadium, tickets will not be needed. Senior wishing to obtain extra tickets (if they become available) will be directed how and when to do so at a later date which will be communicated via intercom announcements.
