GALT JUHSD SUMMER SCHOOL

The Galt Joint Union High School District will be offering the following courses this summer at Liberty Ranch High School from June 13 through July 20. Students that apply for one of these courses must meet the qualifications as outlined in the course descriptions. Unless otherwise noted, priority will be based first upon need and then on the order in which applications were received.

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS for Summer School 2018

Elevate [Math] 10

A summer acceleration program that provides instruction to students that have completed Integrated Math I and will be taking Integrated Math II next school year. This course is designed for students that struggled in Integrated Math I or need a refresher to prepare them to be successful in Integrated Math II.

English 3D

A summer acceleration program that provides instruction to students to help improve their reading and writing skills. The program is designed for students who have been placed into English 3D. Upon successful completion of this program, students will retake the Reading Inventory to determine if they can be moved into the next level of English.

English Language Development

A summer program for English Language Learners to further improve their reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills in English to better prepare them to be successful in their academic classes during the regular school year.

Trigonometry/Pre-Calculus

Our traditional Trigonometry/Pre-Calculus course being offered over the summer for those students that have successfully completed Integrated Math III and want to take AP Calculus AB or BC next school year. Juniors will have first priority for seats in this course.

Credit Recovery

Courses will be offered for student to recover credit during the summer school program in the areas of English, math, social science/history, science, and health. Based on need, these courses may be taught through a traditional classroom model or an online credit recovery model.

Driver's Education (must be at least 15 ½ years old) (not for credit)

A course in driver's education that meets the CA Department of Motor Vehicles Driver's Education requirement to get a Driver's Permit. Students that complete the course will receive a certificate of completion that must be presented to DMV before a student can take the driving test.
