Alhambra High School Dress Code*:

*includes but not limited to the following

The following are not allowed on campus:

1. Bare midsections (standing or sitting)
2. Sleeveless tops, or tops with straps less than *two inches* thick
3. All type of undergarments that can be seen
4. Shirts that are low-cut in the front or back
5. Skirts, dresses, or shorts that are extremely short, have slits that are extremely high, or that may be considered distracting
6. Sagging, overly baggy pants and/or shorts, dragging, or extremely wide-legged pants
 - Pins, staples or rubber bands that attach pants to shoes
 - Pants worn below the level of the natural waist
 - Belt buckles that only depict initials
7. Shirts, bags, backpacks, or other personal articles that depict or allude to violence, cruelty, sex, alcohol, drugs, or tobacco
8. Articles that could be identified as gang-related
9. Jerseys (Alhambra H.S. jersey acceptable) or Pro attire.
10. Footwear that may cause injury or tripping while on campus
 - Flips-flops
 - Any open toed shoes
 - Slippers
 - Shoes that don't have a sturdy sole and/or does not hold the foot in place with a strap at the heel.
11. Chains hanging from pockets
12. Spiked jewelry and plug earrings with sharp backings
13. Any article of clothing that may distract from the learning process

Hat policy:

1. Beanies, bandannas, and headbands are prohibited
2. Official AHS-logo baseball-style caps with the brim facing forward may be worn outdoors only
3. Natural-colored straw hats with a flat brim not exceeding 4" may be worn outdoors only (For medical reasons only)
4. Headwear worn for religious reasons is allowed
5. No hoodies worn over/covering head

Consequences of dress code violations:

Progressive discipline will be enforced and could be as follows:

- Initial Consequences: Warning and confiscation/ change or be issued a loaner/ placed on dress code contract
- Subsequent Consequences can be as follows: home contact, detention, in-house intervention, behavior contract, parent/guardian conference. Parent must pick up item. Any item not picked up will be discarded at the end of the semester
