

School immunization requirements for school attendance for all grades according to Pa. school law

Does the student have the following immunization requirements for attendance in all grades?

- 4 doses of tetanus, diphtheria and acellular pertussis (1 dose on or after 4th birthday)
- 4 doses of polio (1 dose on or after 4th birthday and six months after the last dose)
- 2 doses of measles, mumps and rubella
- 3 doses of hepatitis B
- 2 doses of varicella

In compliance

Does the student have at least one dose of DTaP or Td or DT or DTP, IPV, MMR, HepB and varicella?

Deny admission until one dose of each antigen listed to the left is received.

If the next dose is medically appropriate, did the student receive the final dose(s) within first five days of school?

Did the student provide a completed medical certificate within the first five days of school of all the doses needed to be compliant?

May exclude admission until medical certificate is received.

Place on provisional status and review every 30 days.

- May exclude from school if non-compliance continues past medical certificate date of next scheduled dose.

If entering 7th-12th
Also needs:
1 dose Tdap
1 dose Meningitis conjugate
12th grade requires additional dose of meningitis conjugate after 16th birthday
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
