### **Bullying Prevention**

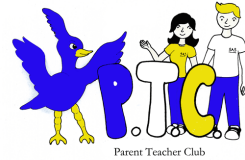

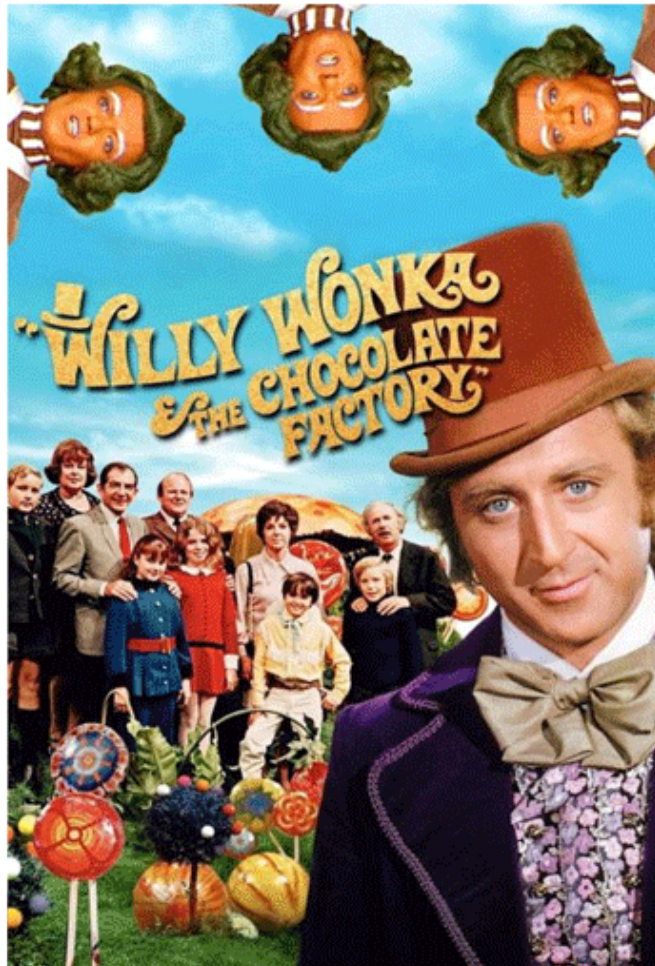
