

SHAC Minutes
October 18, 2010 Meeting

Members Present: Diane Gwinn, Lynn Crabb, Lise Chumbly, Cheryl Hall, Norma Rodriguez, Tricia van Til

SHAC President Diane Gwinn called the meeting to order at 6:30p.m. Cheryl Hall read the notes from the September 13th meeting. Mrs. Chumbly made a motion to accept the minutes as read and Mrs. Rodriguez seconded it. There was no public input and all were in favor.

Mr. Davis discussed the new bond election, and associated costs, location, concerns, and need.

Mr. Davis addressed cell phone sign request. Mr. Davis had written a letter and the signs are now ordered.

Bebe Johnson discussed Life Steps on alcohol and drug prevention. She discussed what they offer on prevention, how the kids are being targeted, and how these items affect the brain. The curriculum is for K-8th, but she recommends 3-5th grades and then maybe 7th grade. There are 10 classes needed with duration of 45 minutes each. Mrs. Lenz to follow-up on if this is feasible to add to curriculum. Is there a date in May? Only cost is workbooks at \$1.00 each.

Mrs. Crabb received crackers and doesn't need any other supplies currently.

P.A.P.A. was reviewed and discussed. It is required by the legislature now. Mrs. Chumbly made a motion for P.A.P.A. to be presented to Mr. Berkhart. Diane Gwinn seconded the motion and all were in favor.

Puberty films for 4th and 5th grade were discussed. The films have been scheduled with Mr. Ball and Nurse Crabb and they are targeting these discussions for December 2010 during P.E.

Cross-walk volunteer marketing discussed. Thoughts were discussed around asking programs such as National Honor Society and other school clubs to

volunteer. Recommendation will be made to Ms. Holt to see about training and feedback on a count of how many may be interested.

Tabled the request from SHAC to Mrs. Pitts for cost of potatoes and salad until next meeting when Mrs. Pitts is available.

Mr. Davis recommended this committee review the Wellness Policy and make suggestions.

Mrs. Chumbly suggested BeBe with Life Steps on tobacco prevention.

Next SHAC meeting scheduled for November 15th at 6:30p.m., elementary library.

Mrs. Gwinn asked about this committee devoting part of the next meeting to assist with ornaments for the giving tree. All agreed to 30 minutes for the giving tree effort and 30 minutes for wellness policy recommendation/review.
