What is the purpose of this survey report?

This report provides detailed information on the responses that LAUSD students, parents and employees gave to the School Experience Survey last spring. The report gives schools feedback from the entire school community to inform their planning efforts.

Starting on page 2 of this report, the right-hand column labeled "LAUSD" shows the combined results for all LAUSD Middle Schools. The LAUSD results can help you make comparisons.

Who was given an opportunity to participate in the School Experience Survey?

All school employees and parents, as well as students in grades 3-12, were asked to complete the survey in Spring 2016. They will have another opportunity to participate in the survey in the 2016-2017 school year.

In Spring 2016, what were the key findings of the survey at Le Conte MS?

Students

In total, 868 students completed the survey.

- 83%** said that they came to class prepared.
- 76%** said that they are happy to be at this school.
- 72%** said that they feel safe when they are at school.

Parents

In total, 755 parents completed the survey.

- 95%** said that they feel welcome to participate at this school.
- 95%** said that their school provides them with opportunities to help them support their child's learning.
- 94%** said that they feel their child is safe on school grounds.

Employees

In total, 50 teachers completed the survey.

- 73%** said that the school's professional development addresses their students' needs.
- 98%** said that teachers at this school have changed their instructional practice as a result of the State Standards.

In total, 77 employees, including teachers and principals, completed the survey.

- 96%** said that this school is a supportive and inviting place for staff to work.
- 100%** said that they feel safe on school grounds during the day.

Definitions

Socio-Emotional Learning (SEL): Self-Management The ability to effectively manage your emotions, thoughts, and behaviors in different situations. This includes managing stress, delaying gratification, motivating yourself, and setting and working toward personal and academic goals.

SEL: Growth Mindset The belief that you can grow your talents with effort. Students with a growth mindset see effort as necessary for success, embrace challenges, learn from criticism, and persist in the face of setbacks.

SEL: Self-Efficacy The belief that you can succeed in achieving an outcome or reaching a goal. Self-efficacy reflects confidence in your own ability to control or manage your motivation, behavior, and environment.

SEL: Social Awareness The ability to take the perspective of and empathize with others from diverse backgrounds and cultures, to understand social and ethical norms for behavior, and to recognize family, school, and community resources and supports.
