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- Immunizations:** Immunization Laws Have Changed (see flyer for more info)

All students need: in ALL grades need the following vaccines:

- 4 doses of tetanus, diphtheria and acellular pertussis** – usually given as DTP or DTaP or DT or Td (1 dose on or after the 4th birthday)
- 4 doses of polio** (4th dose on or after 4th birthday and at least 6 months after previous dose given - A 4th dose not necessary if the 3rd dose was administered at age 4 years or older and at least 6 months after the previous dose)
- 2 doses of measles, mumps, rubella** - usually given as MMR
- 3 doses of hepatitis B**
- 2 doses of varicella** (chickenpox) or evidence of immunity
- 1 dose meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV)**
- 1 dose of tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis (Tdap)** [if five years have elapsed since last tetanus immunization]
- TB testing** for international and high risk students.

12th Grade ADDITIONAL immunization requirement for entry:

- An additional second dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV)
- Physical Exam:** required for **all incoming** students and **11th Grade** (has to have been done since Sept of last year). If you were in a PA school and provided this to the prior school in 6th grade you can submit in 11th grade only.
- Dental Exam:** required for **all incoming students** (has to have been done since Sept of last year). If you were in a PA school and provided this to the prior school in 7th grade you are exempt.

Do you have medications? All forms are found on Website.

Prescription Medication:

- Sent to school in original container from pharmacist.
- Accompanied by note or (**medication policy form**) signed by the parent.
- Physician's order (or **medication policy form with signature**) with complete instructions for dispensing and signature.

Over the Counter Medication:

- Sent to school in original container
- Accompanied by note or (**medication policy form**) signed by the parent.
- Physician's order (or **medication policy form with signature**) with complete instructions for dispensing and signature.

Students requiring an Epi-Pens and/or Inhaler must complete:

- Permission to Carry Form**
