Call meeting to Order

The meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m.

Birgit asked to have a motion regarding our minutes from our TAB Meeting held on January 12, 2017

Dr. Bergmann had a question: He would like to have a copy of the minutes sent to him so he can put them on our school website.

Patty Castreje, Treasurer:

Our budgets were handed out to each booster club. If your paper has a paperclip on it, that amount is what was in your ASB account. This ASB account is what the school will be closing. So the funds that are left in that account will now be deposited into your booster account. We ask you look over the amount to make sure it's correct. The funds will be transferred tomorrow 2/9/17 in your Wells Fargo accounts. This deposit will be reflected on your next month's budget statement.

Patty introduced Bob Houston to the group. He expressed that on occasion he will make a mistake, if this happen please just come to him and he will fix it. In December he had many deposit slips, 9 of them didn't have any information on them. It is very important that the slip are filled out correctly. It makes it very difficult for him to deposit. Also, when emailing please do not send such large files. It makes it difficult for him to open. It would be ideal if you could send hard copies. Should you request a check on Friday, he will have it ready Saturday morning. Wrestling doesn't have an account so Bob asked their rep Tammy Garcia to come over and get it set up. If you need past reports, come by his office and he will give it to.

Bob and Birgit are a part of City Club. They are having their annual party which will be held on March 4th at The Valley Hunt Club. It is \$120 per person and loads of fun. He has invited all of us to attend if we would like.

Dr. Eric Bergmann:

Accounts that were housed at the district the amounts were handed out with the budgets.

Advertising/Banners: The district is going to allow corporate sponsorship and family sponsorship with banners. This is really great news for all booster groups and clubs. However, there will be a few guidelines that will have to be followed. Before you go out and purchase the banners, you must send a mock up version of what you would like to hang. You must email to Dr. Bergmann and DR. They will look it over and then forward it on to the district. Our Superintendent will have the final say on what will be acceptable and what isn't. Also, no one will be allowed to put up anything that is permanent. We ask that your sponsors are appropriate for high schoolers.

Secondly, our boys Basketball team are locked into 3rd place. They are in CIF and we are very proud of them. Girls basketball has had a great year with tremendous improvement. The girls will finish a little under 500, however, we will still submit an At Large Bid. This will be up to CIF if the girls go forward or not. However, because we are combining it with other things we can. So we are encouraging every booster group to set up a table that evening with information of your season, and how they can get involved. This will be a great opportunity to get the freshman parents involved for the new year. We are not going to change our date, we will figure out a way to make sure everyone is able to come out a repersent.
