- VII. New Business: Legal Requirements:**
  - a. Review expenditures and budget- Dr. Salehi shared we are using some money allocated for teachers during their prep period to support students with ELPAC Boot Camp during the school day. We are still offering after school tutoring for students in Math and Language. Currently we have 12-14 students in our tutoring classes. Dr. Salehi asked teachers to go back to their team to ask teachers to recruit. Maybe we can use our Mentor Teachers to help recruit students to the tutoring class and talk to them at the 1/ 31 meeting to remind them of their mentor commitments.
  - b. SWP annual review - Evaluation of Title I programs/services- Dr. Salehi shared the bulk of our Title 1 goes to staffing. We also added 8 sets of Chrome Book Carts that allows us to complete the SBAC within 3 ½ weeks. It will also allow testing to be divided into 2 days so students don't get test fatigue. It will support the relevance of the test with students and teachers so they don't burn out. Once all test schedule is finalized, Dr. Salehi will bring it to the staff and promote multiple teacher trainings, a stress test to see if the system can handle 20 carts, a testing rally on April 13, etc. Testing will start April 16. There will be no testing on Wednesdays, only makeups. Ron suggested we use it as a celebration. Dr. Salehi reflected it should be a good competition. Laura suggested there be a reward for students who reach the goal (dunk tank, water balloons, carnival, etc.)

Dr. Salehi and Paula will review expectations with all classes this week by going in during homeroom including upcoming testing, promotion dress code and requirements for 8<sup>th</sup> grade.

  - a. ELAC/DELAC- The upcoming meeting is 1/26/18.
  - b. AVID- Recruitment for 6<sup>th</sup> grade has started. When we had the 6<sup>th</sup> grade parent orientation, we ran out of application for AVID. 7<sup>th</sup> grade recruitment will start Friday, 1/19/18. AVID students will go in to talk to the students from current 6<sup>th</sup> grade.

- c. Magnet- Same as with AVID, we ran out of applications. Dr. Salehi shared a parent from outside is excited that we offer medical type classes in magnet.
- d. WEB- Mrs. Dufresne is recruiting for next years WEB leaders. Please remind the 7<sup>th</sup> grade teachers to give her a list of students that would be good leaders.
