We teach a gun safety lesson to all cadets. The purpose is to give them the knowledge of what to do if they are around, find, or are associated with a gun. The class room portion is only show and tell; they do not handle a gun. However, we will allow those with a signed permission slip to participate in a practical exercise of shooting an air rifle on our regulation Air Rifle Range.

These rifles use air to send a small pellet 33 feet down range to the intended target. They will receive extensive range safety and rifle safety training before shooting a target.
