## Walk n' Roll Update



Students who walk or roll to school need to stay safe on their journey to and from school. We want to remind students who roll scooters, bikes, and boards, to dismount their vehicles when nearing pedestrians on the sidewalk. Students and parents on scooters, bikes, and boards need to yield to pedestrians by signaling their approach with a bell or horn, coming to a stop when approaching pedestrians, and walking to pass or follow behind. Pedestrians always have the right of way on the sidewalk. Thank you for making Lietz a safe destination to walk and roll to!

## **Registration for New Students (grades TK-8) is Open**

New student registration (for any grade level TK – 8<sup>th</sup>) for the 2018-19 school year is open. Information can be found on the Lietz Website ([lietz.unionsd.org](http://lietz.unionsd.org)).

To be eligible for Kindergarten in the fall, a child's 5<sup>th</sup> birthday must be on or before September 1, 2018. If a child's 5<sup>th</sup> birthday is between September 2 and December 2, 2018, s/he is eligible to attend Transitional Kindergarten during the 2018-19 school year.

## **Safety**

Thank you very much for your continued efforts in making pick-up and drop-off time safe in front of our school. As a reminder, the inner lane closest to the curb is used to pick up and drop off students. The outer lane is for thru traffic. Please do not move from the outer lane into the inner lane. This is unsafe, and disrupts with the flow of traffic. If you are experiencing any issues with traffic safety, please inform the yard duty or come and see me. We would like to ensure that pick-up and drop-off is also smooth on Lietz and Howes (near the back gate). We have two busses dropping off and picking up students. It is crucial that cars do not stop and are not parked along the red curb in this area, so that the busses have enough room to park. More importantly, we want to ensure that those students getting off and on the busses, as well as other students walking in these areas are safe. Thank you!
