The Moreno Valley School Board voted June 17, 2014, to place a \$398 million dollar bond measure on the Nov. 4, 2014, ballot. The community approved Measure M for \$398 million to repair existing facilities as well as construct new facilities for the students of Moreno Valley Unified School District.
