Professional Personnel Leadership Committee Minutes

The March 14, 2018 regular meeting of the Bright Elementary School PPLC was called to order by chairperson, Mrs. Macklin, at 3:16 p.m. in room 205. Members in attendance were: Angel Macklin, Christine Chavez, Savannah Zeien, Samantha Murray, Sara Katzenbach, and Ms. Whitfield (3:20).

Agenda was approved as written. The minutes from the February 14, 2018 meeting were approved as read. The team reviewed old business related to the Rochelle Lee Grant. Team will be on the lookout for emails from the grant in regards to our participation. The new business included reviewing the LSC/CIWP priority updates: MTSS, Instruction, and Rigorous Student Tasks. The team agreed that the PPLC recommendations relating to small group instruction can fall under the priority of Instruction. Our recommendation of small group instruction as a subcategory also aligns with Network 13's push for rigorous, data aligned, small group instruction.

Chairperson Macklin also expressed that parents at the LSC meeting were concerned about low NWEA scores. Grade band leads are in the process of attending Network 13 NWEA Action Plan Meetings. The team collaborated about possible ways to support home to school connection to develop literacy and math skills. The team inquired about the possibility of scheduling family math nights before the end of the year with a tentative date of April 30th for K-5 and May 1st for 6-8. The rationale for a math night would be to support parent engagement and to push data before NWEA testing begins.
