Dear Parents,

It's hard to believe we are getting ready to close another school year. As we begin to plan for the 2018-19 school year, I wanted to share the information below that will be in effect when students return to school. We are always looking for ways to save our parents time and have the best up to date information for our students. This fall, parents will not be filling out the paper/pencil packets to register your students for school. We will be opening the online registration process on August 1, 2018. Instructions for completing the online registration process are available at www.camdentonschools.org. Go to "Resources" and then select the "Enrollment" page. You can access online registration by logging into your SISK12 Parent Portal account. If you do not have a SISK12 Parent Portal account, please contact your student(s) school and register today for a login for the portal. If you do not have a computer at home, please know that we will have Chromebooks at each building that you are welcome to come in and use for the online registration process. We value your time and want to help streamline the registration task with this online process. If you have questions, please contact the building secretary for assistance after August 1, 2018.

We are always looking for ways to ensure your student(s) safety and security while they are here at school. We will no longer post K-6 teacher/classroom lists on the elementary doors in August. Once a parent has registered their student(s) online during the August 1-10 window, K-6 parents may log into their Parent Portal after 4 p.m. on August 10th to see who their student's teacher is for the 2018-19 school year. **Student class placement will not be given out over the phone.** Student schedules for grades 7-12 will not be finalized until 4 p.m. on August 17th.

Beginning with the 2018-19 school year, students will not be permitted in school after September 7, 2018 if they have not completed their state required immunizations/shots. The schedule of state required immunizations/shots is listed below. If you have questions or concerns, please call your school nurse or the Camden County Health Department.
