VII. New Business: Legal Requirements:

- a. EL Program Evaluation- Dr. Salehi shared that we are in the process of evaluating our EL program and looking at the Master Schedule to see how we can improve the programs that will impact the Master Schedule. He shared that students who are classified as EL take general language classes and also an elective in either ELD or AVID Excel. We have tutors pushing into classes to help support our EL students within general education classes. Students must pass the iReady or SBAC language arts section with proficient scores along with the new ELPAC test to reclassify. Mrs. Nord stated she would be happy to provide ELPAC practice in January. Paula asked Mrs. Nord if she would be willing to use her prep time to teach it during the school day. Laura asked if we could share what the ELPAC includes at the ELAC Meeting. Suggestions were made to also share it at January's Coffee with the Counselors.
- b. Review and approve the parent involvement policy- We need to check with Federal and State programs to see if #3 "The Los Alisos Middle School will give each parent timely notice when their child has been assigned, or has been taught for four or more consecutive weeks, by a teacher who is not highly qualified." Still applies.
- c. Discuss ELAC recommendations – There was a concern in regards to the use of Room 114 for parent meetings. There is no conflict in first or second block; we just need to inform Mrs. Dreiling.
