

Which Form to Use?

Please note: If using an Asthma Action Guide, Diabetic Form from physician, or Emergency Health Care Plan (EHCP):

All physician orders and instructions should be written *on these plans*, and additional forms are *not* needed.

If the physician wants the student to carry their own meds, it should be noted on the plan and signed by the physician.

Asthma Medications	Asthma Action Guide	Parent and Physician
Diabetes Care	Form from Dr. or Clinic	Parent and Physician
Emergency Health Care (EHCP) (ie: severe allergies, seizures)	Emergency Health Care Plan	Parent and Physician
Prescription Medication for 2 weeks or less, and given by School Staff	Medication Administration <u>and</u> meds in original container	Parent
Prescription Medication. Daily. All year, and given by School Staff	Medication Administration	Parent and Physician
Non-prescription Medication. As needed, and given by School Staff (parent provides medication)	Medication Administration	Parent
Any medication physician believes should be carried by, and taken by student	Medication <u>Use</u>	K-8: Parent <u>and</u> Physician K-12: Parent
