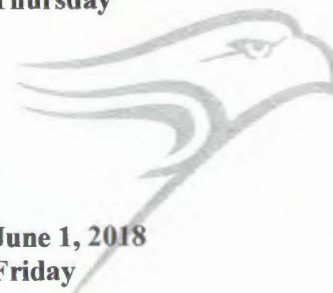

MANDATORY SENIOR CHECKOUT

Senior checkout requires final clearance signatures from all present teachers, Textbook Office, Finance Office, and Library by 3:00pm on **THURSDAY, MAY 24th.** Counselor and Registrar signatures are due by 12:30pm on **FRIDAY, MAY 25th.** Students should bring their student I.D. All present and past debt accrued at Centennial or any other Kern High School District school must be cleared through the Finance Office (**Cash Only**). The Finance Office is open 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. At the end of each final exam period, seniors are to check in their textbooks at the Textbook Office **only. Books are not to be turned in to teachers.** Students may return/clear textbooks until 3:30 p.m. each day of finals. **All clearance forms are due to the Registrar by 12:30 p.m. on Friday, May 25th.**

Tuesday, May 29th

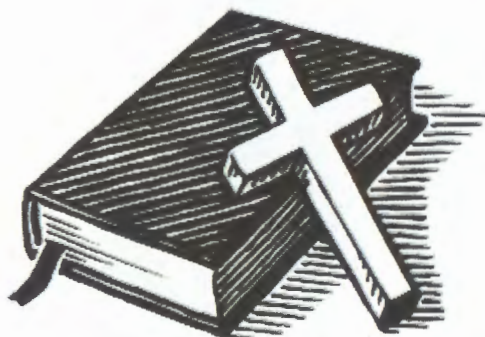

CHECK-IN: All graduates must check-in at 6:15 p.m. in the gym. Wear your cap and gown. Don't forget to bring your cap tassel. Only the designated CHS cap and gown, and CHS honor stoles, cords and medals are approved for graduation. No additional adornment may be worn. Appropriate dress attire and shoes must be worn under the cap and gown.



TICKETS

Each graduate will be given ten (10) tickets for parents and guests for the commencement ceremony. **No additional tickets will be available.** Check with fellow graduates for unused tickets. It is suggested to leave infants and small children at home. Tickets for those with physical disability will be available upon request. Only one attendant per disabled person.

GRADUATION BEHAVIOR

We are a class act and so is our ceremony. Improper behavior will not be tolerated and those involved will be removed. We ask that family and friends be courteous and remain quiet throughout the ceremony during this momentous event. A professional graduation photographer will be present on the field.

GRADUATION PHOTOGRAPHY

A professional graduation photographer will capture each student receiving their diploma. Proofs will be mailed to each student's home in early summer. Personal photo opportunities will be available on the field after the ceremony.



GRADUATION PARKING

Parking will be available on a first come, first serve basis, in the stadium lot, front parking lots, and on the surface streets adjoining Centennial. Special handicap parking will be located adjacent to the stadium.

DISABILITY SEATING

Areas of the stadium will be dedicated for special seating of our physically disabled parents/guests. Only one attendant per disabled person in the designated areas will be allowed. Please contact an usher or school personnel for assistance.

GRAD NITE - DISNEYLAND

Tickets will go on sale Monday, March 12th at 6:00am for the senior Disneyland Grad Nite 2018 trip. Cleared debt form from finance and parent permission slips must be turned in at time of purchase. The \$155.00 cost includes transportation by charter bus; a box lunch from Jersey Mike's and a Disneyland/California Adventure ticket for the GradNite celebration. Only 300 tickets can be sold due to bus seating and only Centennial seniors may sign up. We suggest that you sign up early and purchase tickets with your friends to assure riding on the bus together. Dress requirements will be given out at the time of ticket purchase. Disneyland is strict and enforces its grad nite dress code. We will board the buses at approximately 12:30 p.m. on May 29th. Vandalism warning: Try not to leave your car overnight in the parking lot. All students will be checked for proper dress code. Disneyland is open only to selected high schools from 3:00 p.m. to 2:00 a.m. for an unforgettable night of cutting edge music, dancing, rides, and adventures. You will return back to CHS at approximately 5:00 a.m. On a negative note (but one that must be mentioned), any student detained by Disneyland police will either be transferred to the Anaheim Police Department or be required to have parents pick them up Wednesday morning at Disneyland.
