



When can I apply to the CSU's?

- California State Universities applications become available on Wednesday, **October 1st**

CSU Applications can be submitted between October 1 – November 30 (Apply early, in the filing period)

Make sure you have a copy of the following before beginning your application:

- a copy of your unofficial Culver City HS transcript/Community College transcripts
- Your Social Security number/AB540 students do not need to have a SS# to apply
- Parent income information for qualifying for the fee waiver.
- SAT/ACT scores Sept.-Dec. exams are generally accepted. Some Cal States have their own internal deadlines such as SDSU wants exam completed no later than November.
- Parents' residency information- know the date they moved to California.
- Send your SAT scores from College Board or ACT. Use code 3594 to save money by sending multiple scores to all CSU at once.



CSU Mentor & Financial Aid - work together to make your process easier

- If you are a 12th grader and have already applied to a California State University, you can use the link on CSUMENTOR to populate your general information onto your official FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). Keep in mind, that the FAFSA must be completed between January 1, 2009 – March 2, 2010
