<b>Registration Fee – \$600 Non Refundable</b> Mandatory for all students annually. Includes school technology access, PSAT testing, lab/class fees, classroom supplies, student insurance, emergency packs, personal counseling service, before/after school tutoring, and campus security service.		<b>New Students:</b> Paid at registration <b>Returning Students:</b> (Due by April 1 – \$100 Late fee after June 15)	
<b>Tuition Plans</b> – Single payment plan - 5% Discount, Two payment plan - 3% discount, or Monthly plan with FACTS. All families paying monthly must set up an account with FACTS Tuition Management Service. \$51 service fee to set-up account
